Joyce Ann Hogue was born on Saturday, October 4, 1941 in Pilot Point, Texas, the daughter of Justin and Fannie (Patterson) Jones. She passed this life at Bartlesville Health and Rehab on Monday, October 20, 2025. She was 84 years and 16 days of age.

The former Miss Joyce Ann Jones grew up in Stigler, OK and attended Stigler High School when she met and married the love of her life, Jerry Wayne Hogue, on January 12, 1958. A few years into their marriage they both gave their lives to God and began a life of pastoral ministry together. Whatever was needed, she would do. Cooking and serving meals, leading Bible studies, mowing the church lawn, or working in children's ministry. She took the role of a pastor's wife to heart and served faithfully alongside her husband making a difference in the lives of many until he preceded her in death on June 4, 1991.

Joyce was an accomplished seamstress, queen of DIY projects, and had a heart for care giving as was evident from her early years with her granny and grandad to numerous hospital and home stays with many family members and friends along the way. Joyce was also employed with Bank of Oklahoma for some 21 years servicing loans in the Mortgage Department. 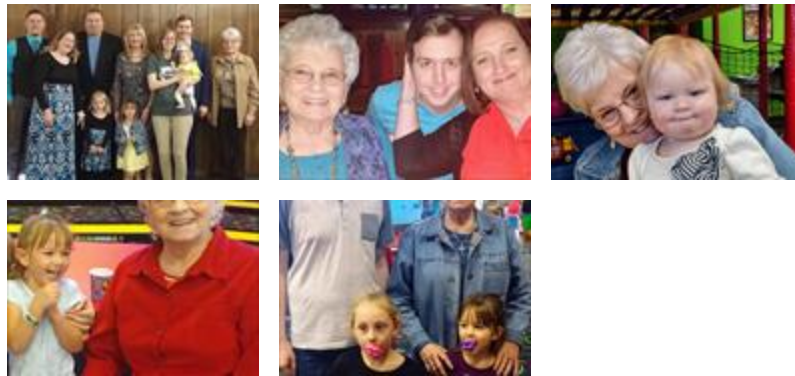

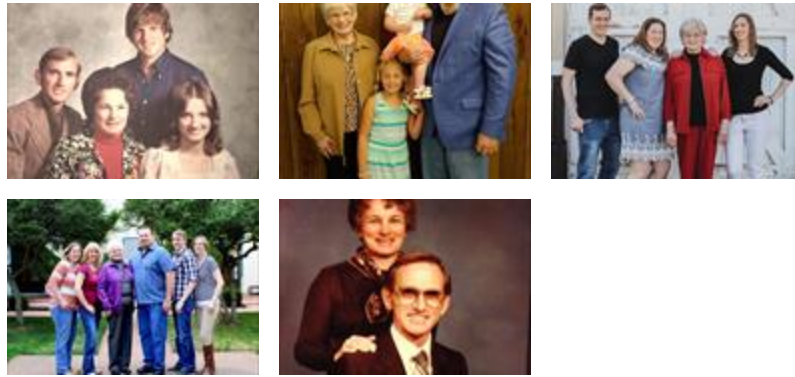
