Kenneth Wayne Wolfkill was born in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on Saturday, December 16, 1944 to Foster and Elizabeth Wolfkill. He passed on Friday, December 30 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, at the age of 78, after a courageous battle against cancer

Kenneth was Ken to family and friends and “honey bear” to his wife. He was an Air Force veteran during the Vietnam War. 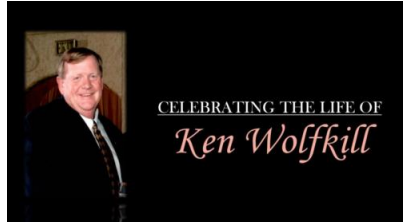
