Ken, the youngest of six siblings, was born in Verdon, Nebraska on September 6, 1938 to William Tobias Lollman and Minnie Theola (Bach) Lollman. Ken passed away in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Thursday, September 5, 2019 at the age of 80.

Ken graduated from Dawson High School in Nebraska in 1956 and went on to serve in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War until his honorable discharge. Ken was a hard worker. He was employed with Monroe Systems for Business for 28 years before he started his own business, Landmark Business Systems in 1989.

On May 20, 1961 Ken married Karel Whitaker in Claycomo, Missouri. Their union was blessed with three children. Ken was a wonderful husband, father and grandfather. He adored his family and loved spending time with them. Ken and Karel loved to travel together exploring new destinations all over the world. Ken loved telling stories and going camping. He had a passion for

restoring old cars and tractors. Ken was active in his community as a member of the Early V8 Ford Car Club, the BA Sam's Camping Club and is former Commander of the BA American Legion. He was a dedicated member of First United Methodist Church of Broken Arrow.

“ A LOVING MEMORY

Being one of Ken's brothers brings many memories of our childhood days, plus many more fun memories during adulthood.

The strongest impression I will always remember is his extraordinary ability to seek out whatever resources he needed to achieve a goal or to overcome a problem that was in his path. This ability was developing during his childhood days. For example, as an 8-year old, or thereabouts, Ken was in charge of feeding and watering the chickens. One day Ken asked if I would help him with a problem in the chicken house. I assumed there was a problem with the watering equipment or whatever. So I agreed to accompany him. After entering the CH (chicken house) I asked where his problem was. He immediately pointed to a large, white, and BIG whiterock rooster prancing around among 200 hens. He was high-stepping around showing off a "cocky" attitude and an impressive set of large feet with "claws" that helped him defend against all comers, including 8-year olds. So how could I refuse? I couldn't turn and run in front of my little brother, let alone from this cocky rooster. So we planned an attack!

After pondering the situation, Ken agreed to stand by the door to the CH and be ready to open it if things went wrong. Now we're ready. I hope.

I took a couple aggressive steps toward the rooster, then turned my back and walked away. Sure enough, that was the move the rooster always waited for - to attack from the rear when you're not looking. However, he didn't know I was watching over my shoulder and saw him coming with his head lowered straight out and his wings spread with the appearance of a takeoff. I waited until he got close behind me and about to jump on me when I turned around and kicked as hard as I could. I caught him squarely under the body and sent him faster than a Saturn rocket to the tin roof of the CH with a resounding thud! Then he dropped back down to the ground with

the second thud while his feathers were landing on his head. After a few seconds with a confused look on his face, he got to his feet and scampered away toward his hens and never looked back. Party over.

This rooster never make the connection as who it was feeding and watering him. He was more interested in being with his hens. Well, he never was right after that, plus egg production seemed to drop because those hens no longer had confidence in him.

The moral of this story is that Ken found his childhood source to help him reach a goal. That ability brought unending results throughout his life. Unfortunately, his source in Houston, Tx. just didn't have the complete medical resources that could cure his affliction. But in the end, Ken sought out the best source available to humankind. His Lord.
