Son, brother, uncle, friend -- what a calling Kerry fulfilled during his 57 years. His beautiful soul departed this earth November 13, 2022, when his Savior called him home. He left behind his mother, Nancy, and his four brothers who invite you to celebrate his promotion.

Kerry Crawford Armstrong was born January 1, 1965, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to parents Bill and Nancy Armstrong, the fourth of five children. In 1967 he and the family relocated to Columbus, Ohio where he spent most of his childhood. In 1983 he and his family returned to his roots in Tulsa, Oklahoma where he graduated from Victory Christian High School in 1984. He was an active church member of Victory Christian Center for three decades and later attended The Assembly in Broken Arrow. Most importantly, he accepted Jesus as his personal Savior at an early age and faithfully served Him all the days of his life.

Kerry worked for QuikTrip and Walmart where providing great customer service was a priority for him. He and his best friend Jeff Cooper shared an interest in Nascar and attended several races together. He was also an avid fan of the OU Sooners football team and often attended games with his brother Kevin. Family and friends from near and far loved his made from scratch lemon meringue pie and his renowned dish "tacos by Kerry." He was a people person who never met a stranger and could always be found with a smile on his face.

Kerry was a living testament of John 15:13- "Greater love hath no man than

this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.” This was most evident in the devotion he had to his family. He committed his lifetime to loving and supporting his parents, caring for them and ensuring no need went unmet.
