Kurt Douglas Francy was born on Sunday, January 24, 1954 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Leonard J.D. “Dee” and Betty (Bear) Francy. He passed from this life on Sunday, February 7, 2021 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma at the age of 67 years old.

Kurt was born with Cerebral Palsy but that never slowed him down. He was the youngest of three children. He had one older brother and one older sister. Kurt was a devout Christian with a beautiful singing voice. He was a member most recently of Heritage United Methodist Church in Broken Arrow. He was a great friend, always making sure his friends’ needs were met before his own.

After Donna’s passing, Kurt lived with his mom until her death. When he was

no longer able to care for himself, he moved into Franciscan Villa and then eventually Forest Hills Assisted Living. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.
