



Kyp Henry Hardaway

July 22, 1962 - July 2, 2015

A Memorial Service for Kyp Henry Hardaway has been scheduled for 2:00 PM, Wednesday, July 8, 2015 at First Baptist Church in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Burial will follow at Park Grove Cemetery under the direction of Hayhurst Funeral Home.

Kyp Henry Hardaway was born in Canyon, Texas on Sunday, July 22, 1962, the son of Henry and Rozelle (Marcy) Hardaway. He died in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Thursday, July 2, 2015. He was 52 years of age.

Kyp was a 1981 graduate of Memorial High School in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He helped the Chargers reach the state basketball tournament in 1980 and 1981. He was selected to the Tournament of Champions all-tournament team. He was an All-State guard in 1981 and was inducted into the Tournament of Champions Hall of Fame in 2008. He attended Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, Oklahoma, Oklahoma Christian in Edmond, Oklahoma and he obtained a Bachelor Degree in Accounting with a minor in English Literature from Northeastern State University in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. Kyp was a Certified Public Accountant at the First National Bank in Tahlequah. He later worked at Arthur Anderson in Oklahoma City, Glenn Elliott in Tulsa, and Local Federal Bank in Oklahoma City. He spent most of his career as the CFO of Candid Color Systems in Oklahoma City. Most recently, he worked for Addvantage Technologies. Kyp was a member of the First Baptist Church in Broken Arrow

and Faith Motorcycle Riders in Broken Arrow. He was a loving father to three sons, Kyle, Jacob, and Henry. He enjoyed reading and technology. He was a very giving person. Memorials may be made to the First Baptist Church Faith Riders, 100 W. Albany St., Broken Arrow, OK 74012.

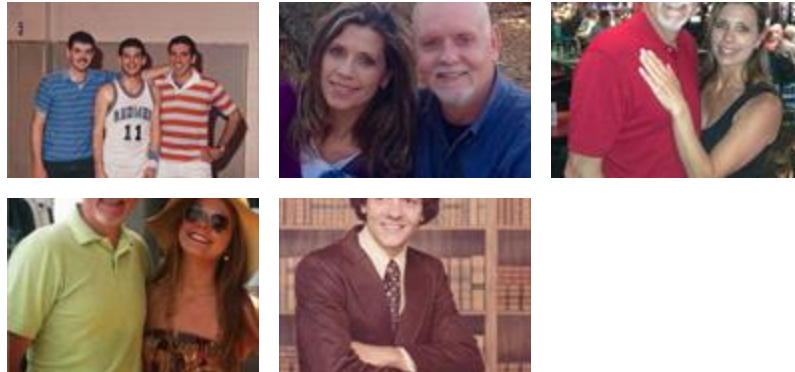
