Larry Lee Allison, 73, passed away on September 9, 2016 in Broken Arrow. Larry was born on September 28, 1942 in Tulsa, OK to the late Edgar and Marilyn Allison. He was the oldest of four children, Herb, Donna, and Edgar who preceded him in death.
