I had full intentions of attending Larry's service. However, yesterday I was diagnosed with Covid. So I am going to do the right thing and stay away from people for a few more days.

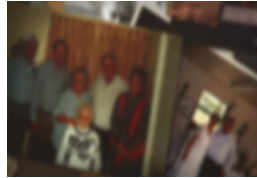
