Larry Donald Osterhout was born on Saturday, December 8, 1945, in Drumright, Oklahoma the son of Reverend James Donald and Etheal Faye (Jenkins) Osterhout. He passed this life on Saturday, July 29, 2023 at his home in Tulsa, surrounded by his family. He was 77 years of age.

Larry was a 1963 graduate of Charles Page High School in Sand Springs, Oklahoma. He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam war and was honorably discharged. He received a degree from the Oklahoma School of Accountancy, now part of the University of Oklahoma - Tulsa. Larry was the accountant and Chief Financial Officer for Utility Supply Company for 43 years.
