They also have a son-in-law, Jeff Hardesty and daughter-in-law, April Hansen Price.

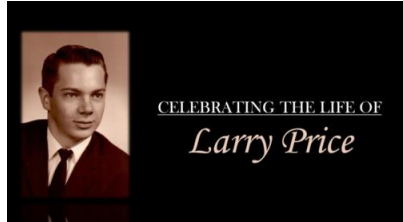
