



## Larry Reynolds

February 6, 1947 - May 6, 2017

A memorial service honoring the life of Larry Reynolds will be 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 10, 2017 at Arrow Heights Baptist Church in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma under the direction of Hayhurst Funeral Home.

Larry Dean Reynolds was born in Ada, Oklahoma February 6, 1947 to Jasper Dean and Wanda Jean (Peck) Reynolds. He died Saturday, May 6, 2017 surrounded by family and friends after a brief but arduous battle with cancer. He graduated from Pauls Valley High School, attended East Central University, Oklahoma State University and graduated from Northeastern State University. Larry was an avid salesman of building supplies and carefully nurtured his relationships with his customers.
