Lawrence Hardy Erwin of Tulsa, passed away Friday, October 1 at the age of 88.

Lawrence was born Saturday, April 8, 1933 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to George and Nancy (Street) Erwin. Lawrence was a graduate of Webster High School in Tulsa where he played football. He was also a great supporter of his beloved OSU Cowboys, and was there to cheer them on every chance he could. He was involved with the Payne County and Oklahoma Historical Societies. He was also voted the Stillwater Citizen of the Year in the late 90's.
