Leonard Russell Jones was born on Saturday, August 5, 1950 in Washington D.C., the son of Russell and Florence Elizabeth Jones. He passed this life at his home in Broken Arrow on Monday, November 11, 2019. He was 69 years of age and now resides in Heaven.

Leonard was a 1968 graduate of Suitland High School in Suitland, Maryland. Although he had some previous college credits, he and his son, Josh, attended school together at Tulsa Community College where he preceded to graduate with his Associates and move on to his Bachelor's before his son; he won that race. He received a Bachelor's Degree in History and a Minor in Archaeology from Langston University. He was married to the former Judy Brenda Wilson on December 17, 1977 in Washington D.C. 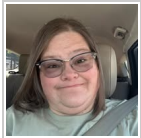
