Leonard Leon Roach of Broken Arrow passed away on Tuesday, July 14 at the Claremore Veterans Center. He was 89 years of age. He was born on March 21, 1926 in Pawhuska, Oklahoma to Charles Roach and Lula Mae Rogers. He grew up at Clear Creek near Hulbert. He was educated at the Indian schools at Wyandotte and Chilocco where he worked in the bakery and carpenter shop.

Len served in the United States Navy as a Seaman First Class during World War II and was stationed in San Diego, California. He married the former Miss Charlett Peters on August 14, 1948 in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. They were married for 66 years. They had two daughters, Audrey and Kathie. Leonard worked at Wonder Bread. He worked for 41 years as a master carpenter and cabinet maker at Oklahoma Fixture Company before retiring in 1992. He was a member of Carpenters Local #329 and the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America. Leonard enjoyed watching his granddaughters Lindsay and Allison participate in band, dance, sports, and school activities. He was a fan of the St. Louis Cardinals, O.U. Sooners, and the Pride of Broken Arrow. He loved fishing, hunting, bowling, gardening, and

driving his tractor on the Peters' farm.
