“ My Grandma Heusman was a beautiful, gentle, elegant woman who took particular delight in cultivating my mind. When I was four, for example, she encouraged my mother to announce not only the titles of the books she read aloud to me, but also their authors, publishers, copyright dates, and anything else that might help me track down similar books in the future. This one incident helped to broaden my world exponentially over the years. As I was growing up, Grandma continued to train my mind by teaching me the most proper, sophisticated, or scientific words for things. A cell phone was “a mobile device”--and I felt that this phrase had much more class than the more common, boring “cell phone” designation. On one memorable occasion, when Grandma learned that I was studying French, she invested in a compilation of classic stories in that language and sent the entire stack of audio CD's my way--a precious gift indeed. Another time, she made a special recording of songs from her childhood and teenage years, including a particularly silly song about a cave man called “Alley-Oop”. I loved it!--I really needed the laughter that that recording provoked. Best of all, though, Grandma Heusman was instrumental in fueling some of my Christian education. For my ninth birthday, she presented me with several dramatized children's Bible stories on cassette. Later, she gave me an audio copy of the Living Bible, and I treasure it to this day; for at least the first two years after I rededicated my life to God, it was my mainstay for Old Testament Bible study. Best of all, though, Grandma got in touch with the Lutheran Braille Workers in order to present me with a copy of the Gospels--four bulky but beloved volumes containing all the Truth I will ever need. I read those portions of Scripture voraciously all throughout my formative years, devouring them at home and at school

until my spiritual life flourished into full gardens of joy. I praise God for using Grandma Heusman to draw me closer to Himself, by making sure I was exposed to His Word.

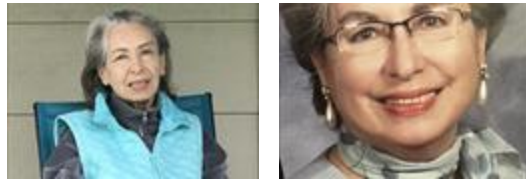
