



Lincoln "Butch" Summers

Lincoln Edward Summers was born in Shattuck, Oklahoma on November 23, 1948 to Carl and Carolea (Booth) Summers. He stepped into the presence of his Lord and Savior at the age of 75 on Sunday, September 15, 2024.

His family moved to Pampa, Texas where he was raised and attended school. In 1966 he joined the United States Army. He served in South Korea for 18 months as a helicopter gunner and crew chief and in Vietnam in 1972 as a helicopter technical inspector. After his discharge in November of 1973 he then served 2 years in the Texas National Guard where he was promoted to Staff Sergeant.

After returning from Korea he met and married Lora Gail Brewer on June 6, 1970. Their son Michael was born in 1972 while Lincoln was serving in Vietnam and daughter Misty joined their family in 1975. Upon returning to civilian life in 1973 he worked for Cabot Corporation and Ingersoll Rand as a welder. In 1994, he and Gail moved to Broken Arrow, Ok. to be close to their grandchildren and he worked as a welder for Matrix Services at the Port of Catoosa until his retirement.

Lincoln was a member of Our Finest Hour Church in Coweta, Ok. and loved the Lord with all his heart.
