September 16, 1976 - July 13, 2025

With heavy hearts and enduring love, we share the passing of Lorie Joann Hubbard, who left this world on Sunday, July 13, 2025, in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, at the age of 48. Lorie was the beloved daughter of John Curtis and Gloria (Lacambra) Wiley born in Jacksonville, Florida on Thursday, September 16, 1976.

Lorie lived a life marked by compassion, creativity, and a deep devotion to those she loved. A woman of strength and grace, she earned two Associate Degrees and served as an Administrative Assistant at Tulsa Pediatric Group, where her warmth and kindness touched the lives of many.
