A celebration of his life will be held at The Assembly (South Campus) in Broken Arrow on May 22, 2019 at 1:00 pm. Viewing will be at the funeral home on Tuesday, May 21 from 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. with family there to receive visitors from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Burial will be Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. at Greenwood Cemetery, Eufaula, Oklahoma.

In his lifetime, Marcus L. Alexander conducted more than a thousand revival meetings preaching to thousands upon thousands of people all across the Southwestern United States. He also pastored six different congregations including Faith Assembly of God in Tulsa, and First Assembly of God in Muskogee. Many people today testify to having received Christ under his ministry. Marcus was always an encourager and helped mentor others in their life and ministry.

Marcus was called “the Walking Bible” for his memorization of Scripture often quoting hundreds of verses with each sermon! In addition to his having memorized all of the New Testament and most of the Old, he was also an academic scholar having graduated from Southwestern Assemblies of God University, in Waxahachie, TX and also attended the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary in Springfield, Mo.

Marcus also served on the tribal council of the Western Cherokee Nation of Missouri and Arkansas, often praying over their meetings in their native Cherokee language.

Marcus Alexander is survived by his wife Naoma of 65 years of marriage. He is survived by two sons: Dr. Marcus P. Alexander and wife Marsha of Garland, TX; Kevin Alexander and wife Stacy, of Muskogee, OK; and one daughter Elaine Alexander of Eufaula, OK. He is Survived by 6 grandchildren; 7 great grandchildren; one brother Gary and wife Danell of Sacramento, CA.; and by one sister Ivonne Wade of Eufaula, OK and special cousin Rhea Parish of Eufaula, OK. Marcus is proceeded in death by his parents Lester Alexander and Ida Mae (Burns) Alexander, brothers Joel Alexander, Dennis Alexander, Roger Alexander, and sister Margie Alexander Bartlett.
