Marie "Mamie" T. Fulps-Stith passed away Thursday, November 5, 2020 at the age of 90.

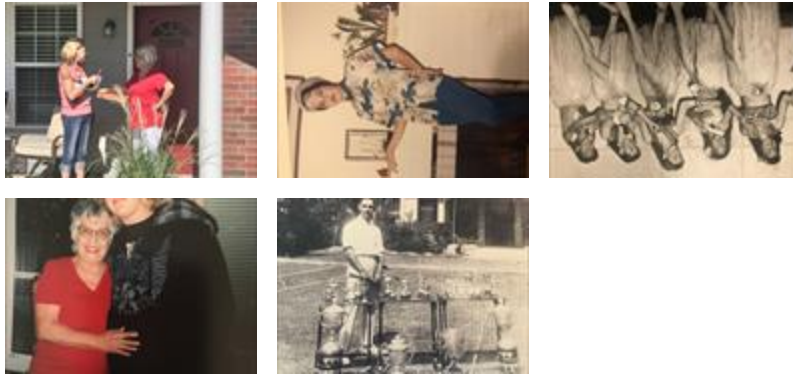

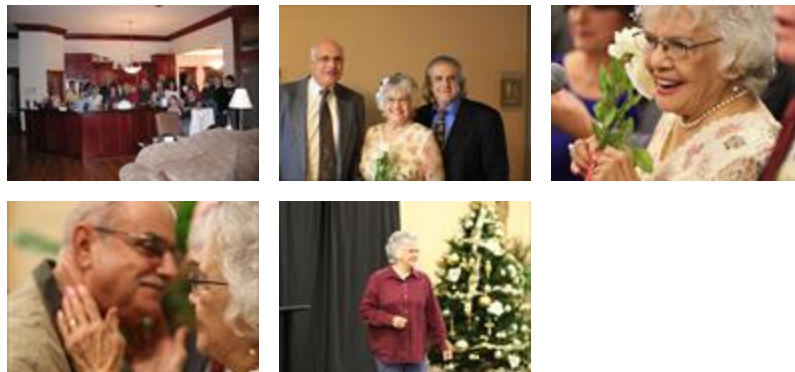

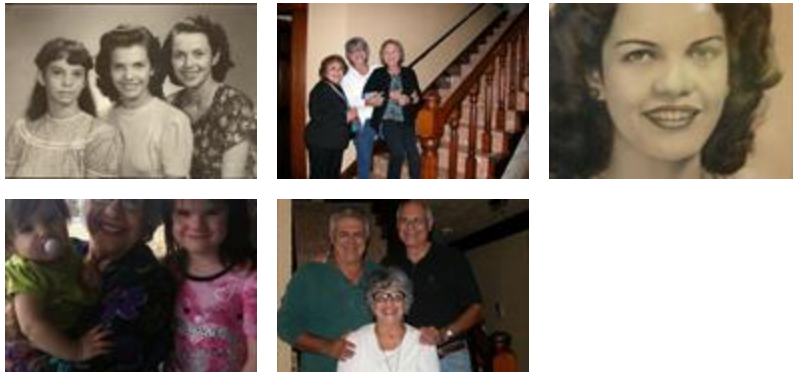
