Mark moved to Broken Arrow with his family and was a 1997 graduate of Broken Arrow High School, where he played football and soccer for the BA Tigers. He was a huge OU fan and enjoyed playing fantasy football. Mark played soccer in Europe when he was younger and had many fun memories of those events. He was an avid sports fan.

While managing Flying J's truck stop, he met a man that had a history of time in prison. He was concerned that the man didn't have a way to get to and from work without the ability to get a loan for a car due to his background. Mark's generosity was shown by loaning money for the car and in turn, the man was able to pay the car loan off.

There were other stories of Mark helping others and being "paid back" in meals. Mark would sometimes say that the meals weren't great, but he would thank them anyway and was gracious for the hospitality of those he had helped through the years.

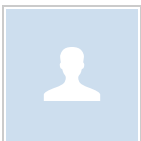

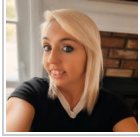
