



Marvin Frank McCutchen

March 5, 1928 - August 6, 2020

Marvin McCutchen, loving husband & father, passed from this life on Thursday, August 6, 2020 at the age of 92 at his daughter's home in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

Marvin was born the oldest of five children on March 5, 1928 in Forrest, New Mexico to Van and Celeste (Buttram) McCutchen.

Marvin grew up on a farm and learned the value of hard work alongside his parents and siblings in Forrest. He attended school there graduating in 1946, actively playing both basketball and running track. Many consider him the greatest basketball player to ever come out of his high school. After graduation, he served in the U.S. Army from 1950 – 1952 in Company C, 412 Engineer Construction Battalion. While on leave one week visiting his sister, he met the love of his life, Mary Louise Boarman. They corresponded until he was honorably discharged to the Army Reserves in November 1952. Upon his discharge, he returned to his home in Forrest.

Marvin and Mary were married on June 21, 1953 in Tucumcari, NM. They moved to Amarillo, TX immediately following their wedding, where he was employed at Amarillo Hardware. They lived there for 13 years and then moved to Portales, NM where he worked in the Data Processing Department at Eastern New Mexico University. He retired as the Operational Manager of the Computer Center in 1989.

They raised two wonderful children, Van Mark McCutchen and Della Diane McCutchen Rogers. Marvin & Mary were married for 62 years until her

passing in 2016.

Marvin was a loving father and involved with all of his kids' school activities. He and Mary would take the family to Ute Lake, where they loved to fish and swim and later, they shared that love with their grandchildren. Marvin was a huge Dallas Cowboys fan and enjoyed watching all sports on TV. He also loved watching western movies.

His children and grandchildren describe him as patient, gentle, loving, extremely sweet and he could always be heard whistling early in the morning.
