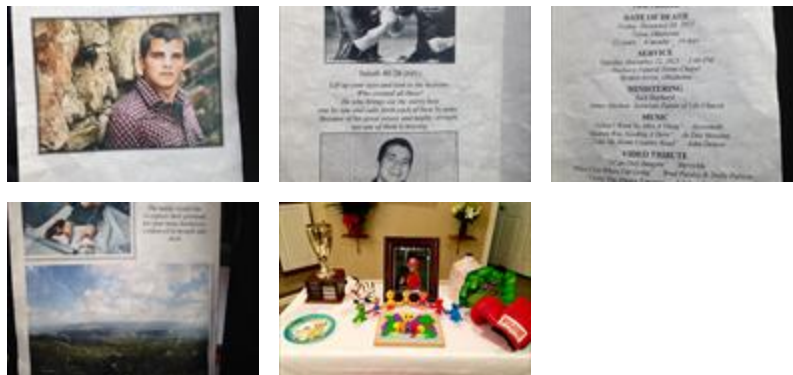

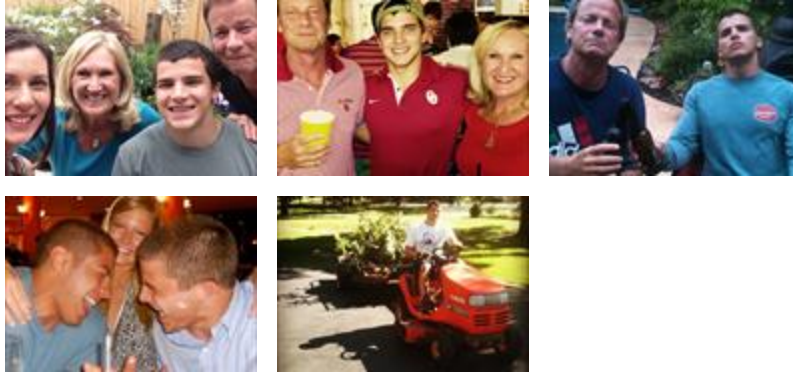
We will all miss you Blake but we know you are with The Heavenly Father, Prince of Peace.

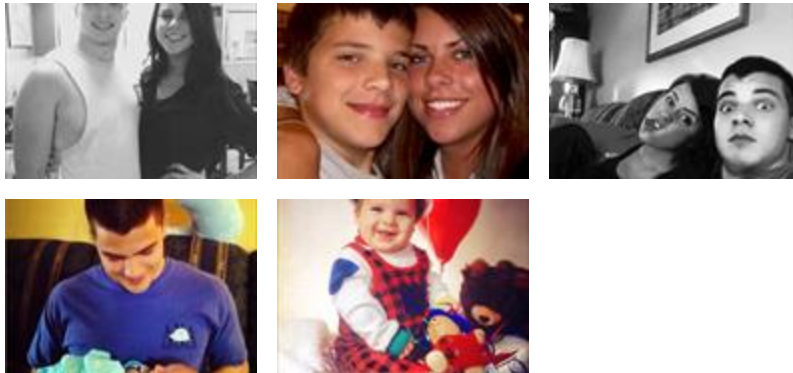

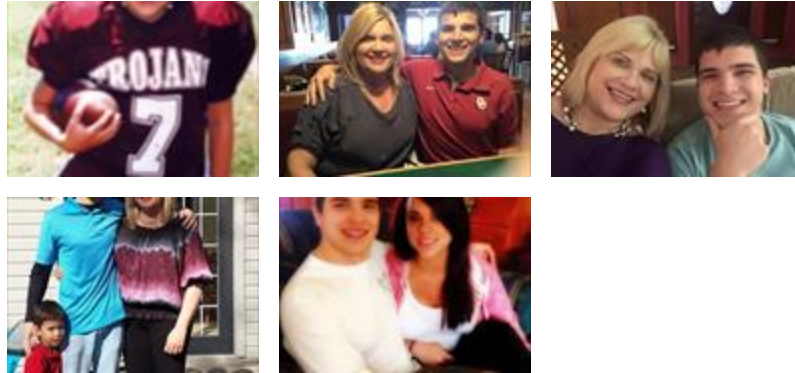

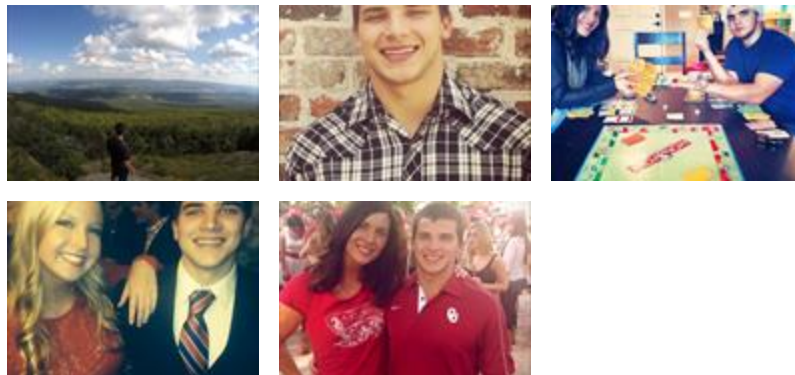
