Mike Mullman of Broken Arrow passed away Thursday, May 12, 2022 at the age of 79.

A memorial service honoring his life will be held 1 pm, Saturday, May 21, 2022 at St. Stephen's United Methodist Church in Broken Arrow.

Mike was born Thursday, October 22, 1942 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Otto and Margaret (Converse) Mullman.
