Newt J. Mann, Jr. was born in Obion County, Tennessee on Monday, November 21, 1932 to Newt Johnny Mann, Sr. and Novie (Roark) Mann. Newt passed away in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Monday, October 22, 2018 at the age of 85.

Newt graduated from Clarksburg High School, Clarksburg, TN in 1951 and later attended Bethel College in McKenzie, TN for a short time. After graduating high school, he worked in a gasoline and tire store and later for Publix Shirt Company as a pattern marker. He was drafted into the United States Army in 1953 during the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1955. After returning from the service, he began a career in the Insurance business as a salesman and office manager and was transferred to Tulsa, OK in 1973 as a manager with National Life and Accident Company. He retired in 1988 from the insurance industry.

On May 1, 1955 Newt married Jennie Moore and their union was blessed with

three daughters, Jennifer Robertson, Andrea Reutlinger and Sandra McWilliams. Newt was a devoted son, brother, husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather. He adored his family and cherished the time he spent with them. He was an avid fisherman and loved spending as much time as possible on the lake with friends and family camping and fishing and enjoying God's creation. He also cherished the time he spent cooking fish for family and church dinners. He always had lots of help from his fishing buddies preparing the fish for church fish fries. He also loved watching his grandchildren play sports and enjoyed watching sports on TV (OSU Football and Oklahoma Thunder Basketball).

Newt never met a stranger and enjoyed many friends through the years and loved his church family at Northside Christian Church in Broken Arrow, OK where he had been a member since 1973.
