Nita J. Sturgeon was born on Wednesday, November 29, 1933 in Coweta, Oklahoma, the daughter of John Samuel and Louella Catherine (Noblet) Wood. She passed this life on Tuesday, February 8, 2022 at her home in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. She was 88 years, 2 months and 10 days of age.
