Norma Jo Jernigan was born August 5, 1947 in Tulsa, Oklahoma the daughter of Jesse and Anita (Gault) Grant. She died at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa on Saturday, February 1, 2020.

She was 72 years of age.

The former Miss Jodi Grant attended Luther Burbank Elementary School where she made lifelong friends. She continued at Alexander Bell Junior High and graduated from Will Rogers High School in Tulsa, Oklahoma with the class of 1965. She started a dog grooming business to support her sons, Victor and Randy whom she loved dearly. Jodi was certified to provide care for the developmentally disabled and worked in that field for about 15 years. During that time, she met Duie Jernigan, they had many things in common, including travel, the outdoors and a love for family, and they married in May 18, 2005 in Hawaii. The Outback Ranch at Stone Bluff was purchased in 1976 and she lived there for 47 years. They shared her ranch with everyone including churches, friends and family. She loved the Ranch! Her outgoing personality made her easy to like and gave her many close friends and

special relationships. She enjoyed snow skiing, gardening and co-owned a Handcrafted Soap Shop with her sister. Jodi and Duie attended Woodlake Assembly and they greatly enjoyed their Christian family.
