Ola was born in Weleetka, Oklahoma on December 23, 1926 the daughter of Doy and Nancy May (Barnes) Peninger. Ola went to be with the Lord in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at the age of 90.

Ola graduated from Tulsa's Daniel Webster High School in 1944. On September 2, 1944 she married Lloyd A. Crew in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Their 57 year union was blessed with three children. Ola was a wonderful wife and mother. In 1981 the family moved and made their home in Broken Arrow. Ola was a lifetime member of Carbondale Community Church (later changing its name to Carbondale Bible Church and then Calvary Bible Church). She was an active member of the church and a Sunday School Teacher. Ola also served in the ministry with her husband at the White Church in Broken Arrow for several years, where she enjoyed playing piano.

Ola, adored her family and loved spending time with them. She was a Godly, gracious, kind, gentle and loving woman who enjoyed taking excellent care of her family. Children and animals always held a special place in her heart.

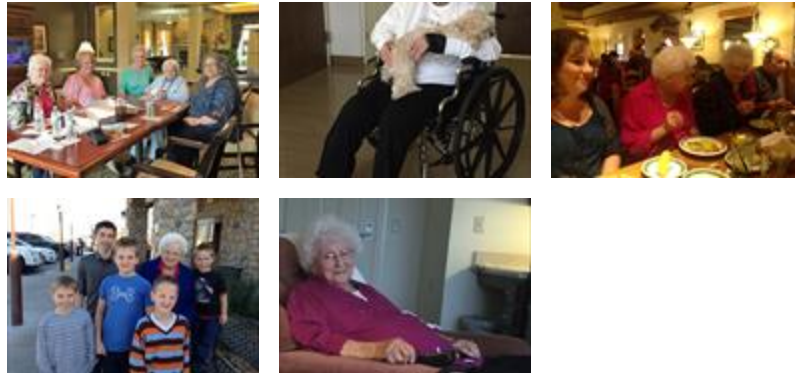
