Olga Ciz Webb was born on July 1, 1925, in Daysland, Alberta, Canada, the third child of eight born to Dmitro and Maria Ciz. She passed away November 13, 2015, at Cedarcrest Care Center in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, after a courageous battle with Alzheimer's. She was 90 years old.

She took great pride in her Ukranian heritage and her devotion to her Catholic faith. She was petite in stature, but strong in spirit. As a young woman, she traveled from her small prairie town to Fort Nelson in the cold desolate corner of British Columbia, Canada, to work on the army barracks.

She later met and married William Webb, celebrating nearly 60 years of marriage. Olga and William raised their two sons (Delbert and Patrick) and one daughter (Alanna) in Brazil and various places in the US including Bradford, Pennsylvania, before settling down in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, in 1968.

She did work as a retail bookkeeper, and also managed a maternity store. She was very creative, with hobbies including petit point, crochet, ceramics, painting, and beading. She was a wonderful cook, known for her apple pie and mint chocolate chip cookies.

Her smile, wonderful sense of humor, and loving nature touched everyone she met, never diminishing. She loved her family so much, always keeping them her top priority, and it showed in the warm home she created.

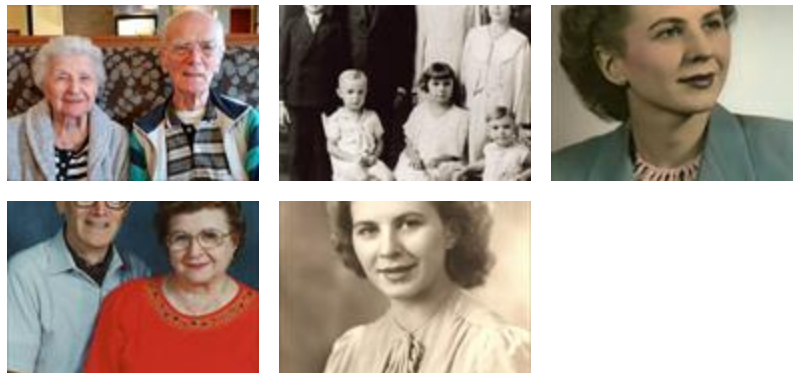
