On the 11th of August, 1950 in Springfield, Missouri, Pamela Carol was born to Alfred and Frances Boatright.

In 1955 the Boatright's moved from Springfield, Missouri to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma and established a Café on Main Street in the area of where 1st National Bank is now located, named "Al's Café".

Pamela and her sisters, Linda and Beverly worked at the family restaurant during their early years, until graduating Broken Arrow High School and starting their own lives. Pamela went 'North to Alaska' to marry her high school sweetheart, Jerry C. Medlin at Elmendorf Air Force Base in Anchorage, Alaska on June 27th, 1970. After their tour of duty in Alaska, their next stop was Minot Air Force Base in Minot, North Dakota. On their Honorable discharge from the United States Air Force, the couple returned to Broken Arrow to set up their permanent home in September of 1972.

On March 11th, 1973 they welcomed their 1st child, a daughter, Stephanie Dawn and on March 3rd, 1982 Pam and Jerry welcomed their 2nd child, a son, Clifton Jerry "CJ".

Pamela and Jerry are both Broken Arrow High School graduates – Class of 1968.

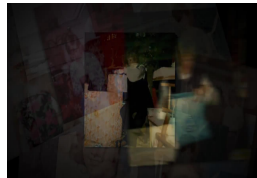
