Perry Ward Partney was born on August 24, 1938 in Tulsa OK, and was called home to be with the Lord on September 3, 2020, surrounded by his family, in Broken Arrow, OK. Perry was preceded in death by his father, Ernest Partney and his mother, Ina Jewel. Perry was also preceded in death by his three brothers, Jim, Gary, and Ken. Perry served in the Army, with the 3rd Armored Division as an armored scout and jeep driver in Germany during the Cold War. He also served with the Lonestar 49 Armored Division during the Cuban Missile Crisis.

Perry attended Central High School and went on to the University of Tulsa where he graduated in 1970. Most importantly, Perry married the love of his life, Yvonne Rearick, on September 16, 1960 after only a nine-month courtship. Perry worked as an insurance agent for State Farm Insurance Company beginning in 1971 and retired from there after thirty-five very successful years in 2006. Perry enjoyed woodworking, fishing at Roaring River in Missouri, going to Red River, NM, working on his 1952 Jeep Willy, spending time with his family, and attending Gaither Vocal Band concerts. Perry is survived by his wife, Yvonne Partney of Broken Arrow, OK, daughter, Joanna Due (Lowell), of Coweta, OK, daughter, Jennifer Fisher (David) of Tulsa, OK, and daughter, Julia Edwards (Chris) of Wagoner OK, and seven grandchildren.
