Mr. Philip Benedict Promessi, 89, of Broken Arrow passed away Wednesday evening in Broken Arrow. He was born in Pittsburg, California on Sunday, February 11, 1934 to Vincent and Gerolma (Cardinale) Promessi. He was preceded in death by both parents, wife, Carol Promessi, and one granddaughter.

Philip served in the US Army, Specialty number 113.30, had the title of Infantry Operations and Intel Specialist. He was a sharp shooter, and received the Good Conduct Medal for his service in Korea, October 1955 to April 1957. He received an honorable discharge due to injury.

He was a member and Commodore of the Pittsburg Yacht Club, he was Port Captain and also a member of the International Order of the Blue Gavel where he was Sergeant-at-arms and educational director.
