Randie began her 40 year career working within the automotive filtration industry (Fram, Facet, Purolator) and ended her working career retiring from US Postal Service. Randie was able to work on many unique projects including government contracts for filtration needs of the Patriot Missile air defense system. In 1991, she was a recognized guest of Ohio Congressman Bill Gradison of the 102nd Congressional Ways & Means Committee.

Love of Christ and Service

Following Jesus Christ in baptism, she was a member of First Baptist Churches in Chelsea, ..., and Broken Arrow before moving her membership to Battle Creek Church. She served various roles in both FBCBA and Battle Creek including nursery, toddler, preschool, grade school and even special needs teaching the next generations about the love of Jesus.
