Raymond Eugene Utt was born on Tuesday, February 26, 1929 in Shidler, Oklahoma to parents Walter and Hattie (Dix) Utt. He left Tulsa, Oklahoma to meet his Lord and Savior on Saturday, September 20, 2025 at the age of 96. Ray was one of four children raised in Oklahoma and he saw a lot of change in his lifetime. Ray served in the United States Air Force and served in the Stars and Stripes as a photographer. He had the opportunity to photograph some famous people such as the marriage of Queen Elizabeth, Franklin Roosevelt and John F. Kennedy. After completing his service he met this lovely young lady, the former Betty Hammer. He was smitten and after their courtship and engagement they were married in Earlsboro, Oklahoma on Friday, June 15, 1956. They were married 68 years upon her passing, January 15, 2025.

Ray then became the photographer for Cities Service being with them over 35 years and had many opportunities to travel the world. He was a member of the Professional Photographers of Oklahoma, serving as President for many years. During his time, he was highly awarded for his photographs. His true joy was taking pictures and then making picture books and giving them to those folks he photographed. He loved camping with Betty and others in the Rainy-Day Campers group at St. Stephens United Methodist Church of which they were founding members. Ray was an avid OU football and ORU basketball fan.
