Robert "Bob" Emile Schluter was born in Arabi, Louisiana on December 7, 1928 to Hermann and Mary (Andry) Schluter. Bob passed away in his Tulsa, Oklahoma home on Thursday, April 13, 2017 at the age of 88.

After graduating from high school, Bob joined the United States Air Force, where he served as a Ground Safety Specialist. He achieved the rank of Staff Sergeant. Following the Air Force, he earned a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Louisiana State University. He worked as an Industrial Engineer in the Aerospace and Manufacturing industries for a number of years. He worked for Boeing on the Apollo Moon Program. He was the Chief Industrial Engineer for the Daisy BB Gun Company. He later joined the Defense Logistics Agency as a Contract Administrator. He retired from the Defense Logistics Agency in 2003.
