Ronald Lee Horn of Broken Arrow went Home to be with The Lord on Thursday, May 5, 2022, at the age of 73.

Ron was born Friday, January 7, 1949, in Joplin, Missouri to Arthur and Hazel (Hunley) Horn. He graduated from Riverton High School in Kansas and received his bachelor's degree in mathematics from The University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and his master's degree in computer science from the University of Kansas (KU). He worked as a computer systems analyst at Linde Process Plants, Inc. where he retired. He previously worked for the National Security Agency (NSA) in Washington D.C.

On December 26, 1980, Ron married the love of his life, Melody Deatherage Bressman, in Broken Arrow. He loved spending time with his family, camping, fishing, and traveling to the Smoky Mountains, Disney World and going on cruises. He dedicated his entire life to his wife and family. 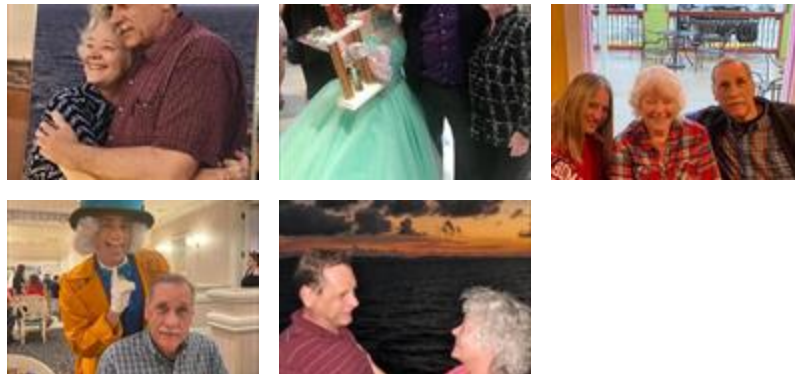
