Ronald Jervis was born on Tuesday, December 14, 1937 in Macclesfield, England, the son of Richard and Gladys Jervis. He passed this life on Thursday, January 11, 2024 at Brookdale Senior Living in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. He was 86 years of age.

Ron moved to the United States with his family when he was 14 years of age, receiving his citizenship in 1970. He graduated from high school in 1955 while living in Tennessee. Ron was a veteran of the United States Army. He married the love of his life, Donna on October 26, 1963 in Nashville, Tennessee. He was a very devoted husband and father. His family and friends knew him as "Pops." He resided with his family in the Nashville area until his work for Ford glass brought him to Broken Arrow. 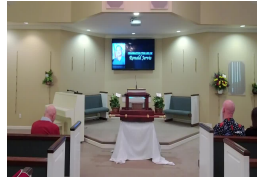
