



Ronald Coley Leaverton

January 25, 1932 - October 15, 2020

Funeral services for Ron Leaverton have been scheduled for 10:00 AM, Monday, October 19, 2020 at the Hayhurst Funeral Home Chapel in Broken Arrow. Rev. Bryan Church, associate pastor of First Baptist Church in Broken Arrow will officiate. Burial will be at 2:00 PM at Sallisaw City Cemetery under the direction of Hayhurst Funeral Home.

Ronald Coley Leaverton was born on Monday, January 25, 1932 in Stillwater, OK, the son of Dale J. and Nellie (Coley) Leaverton. He died at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa on Thursday, October 15, 2020. He was 88 years of age.

Ron was a 1950 graduate of Stillwater High School. He received a football Scholarship from Oklahoma A&M (OSU). Following two years of college he was drafted in the United States Army, serving in Korea. Following the war, he worked for McDonald Douglas and American Airlines . He met his wife Carolyn in 1961 and they married in 1965. and had their daughter Karen Diane. He joined the IBEW # 584 as an electrician in 1966 and retired in 1995. After retirement he worked at Fine Airport Parking, with his Step son Mike Fine for 24 more years.

Ron enjoyed woodworking, and was a 32nd degree Mason. He joined the Akdar Shrine in 1969, the Merri Makers Unite, and was active as a Tramp Clown, winning numerous trophy's. He rode the High Wheeler Bike, and later

a Model T Small Car. He was a member of the American Legion, As a hobby he loved Wood Carving, and Ron's leather work won several Blue Ribbons at the Tulsa State Fair.

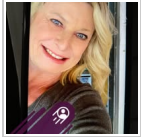

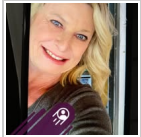

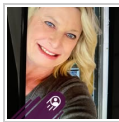
