Ruth Virginia Gitchell was born on Sunday, September 10, 1933 in Grand Junction, Colorado to John and Elsie (Bliss) Gitchell, the 10th of 11 children; she was the last surviving sibling of 6 sisters and 4 brothers. On February 20, 2018, surrounded by family, Ruth passed from this life into the waiting arms of her Lord and savior, Jesus Christ.

Ruth met and married Roy Gable, Jr. in Dallas, Oregon on October 1, 1950, at the age of 17. The next 8 years would see this incredible woman give birth to 6 children, 5 girls and 1 boy, all in Oregon. Although there were rough patches in those early years her children can't remember hearing her complain. Ruth was preceded in death by Rebecca Dale, her youngest daughter and her beloved husband of 60 years, Roy.

Ruth had a bit of gypsy in her and loved to hit the road, the Oregon coast being her favorite destination. Undoubtedly one of her most memorable journeys was to the California Redwoods with all 4 of her daughters; many precious memories were made on that trip. One final excursion to Oregon

had been on her mind for some time, but God had other plans.

Ruth was a very resourceful woman; her children called her the strongest woman that they have ever known. She didn't allow adversity to get the better of her, and she didn't complain. She found great comfort in her faith and God's everlasting grace.

Ruth leaves quite a legacy, in addition to her 6 children she leaves 29 grandchildren; 42 great grandchildren; and 17 great-great grandchildren! More than anything else Ruth would want to be remembered for the spiritual legacy she passed down to her children and grandchildren.

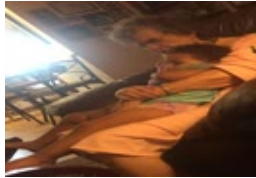

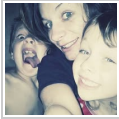

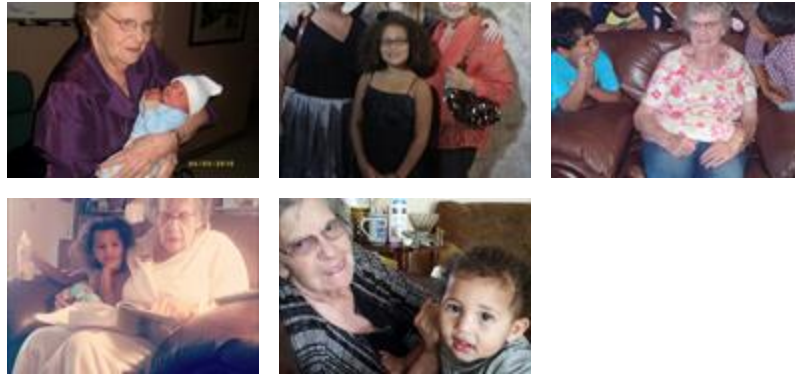
