



Sandra "Sandy" Sue Montgomery

October 12, 1941 - May 31, 2022

Celebration of Life for Sandy Montgomery has been scheduled for June 17th at 11:00 am at First Baptist Church, Broken Arrow. Visitation will be on June 16 from 5-7 pm at Hayhurst Funeral Home, Broken Arrow. Burial will be at Park Grove Cemetery in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

Sandra "Sandy" S. Montgomery was born October 12, 1941, in Inglewood, California to Marion and Ethel Hall Deonier. She passed from this life at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa on May 31, 2022. She was 80 years old.

Sandy completed all twelve years of schooling in Broken Arrow, graduating with the class of 1959.

She received a bachelor's degree in Education and Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction from Northeastern State University in Tahlequah. The former Miss Sandy Deonier married Jack Montgomery on June 27, 1964, in Broken Arrow. They welcomed a son, Matthew David on October 11, 1971. Jack preceded Sandy in death on May 26, 2007.

Sandy was employed with Broken Arrow Public Schools as a teacher and Instructional Coordinator. Later she was also employed at Northeastern State University as an Adjunct Professor and University Coordinator in Clinical Education.

As a lifelong learner who loved teaching, interacting with people and learning new things, she brought new programs to Broken Arrow. She volunteered at Gilcrease as a “Gilly”, visit Nursing Homes, knitted with her knitting group, hosted friendship teas, worked with the BA Arts and Humanities Council to name a few. She taught a Bible Study with Women in Recovery. “Loving on these ladies and leading in the study of God's word is the single most important work I have done in my life.” Others might disagree because so many people benefited from Sandy's work in many areas.

She has been an active part of First Baptist Church her entire life.

Sandy was one of a kind, an educator with a servant's heart who leaves quite a legacy.

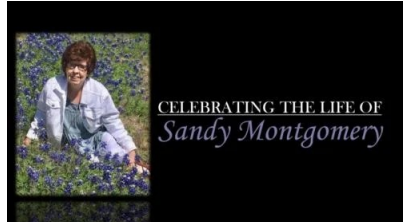

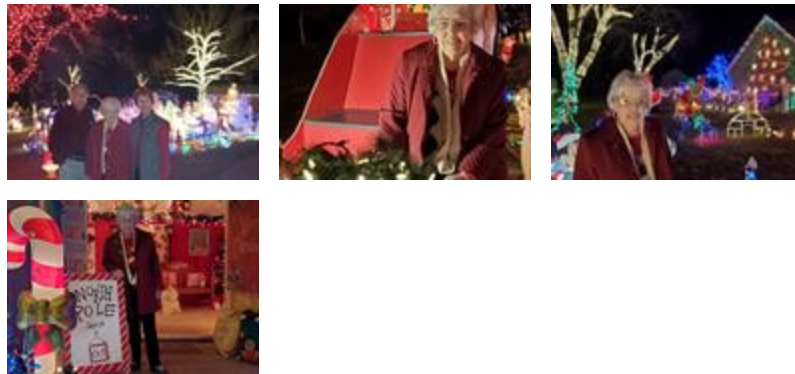
