Sherry was also a good listener to new moms, like me. She was filled with common sense, motherly wisdom and a listening ear when we came to pick up our babies. Early one school day afternoon, one of my students spotted a tornado forming about a mile and a 1/2 west of our outdoor prefab building. As I quickly rushed my 6th grade students at Sequoyah into the main part of the building, i suddenly realized the tornado was forming near Sherry's house (It touched down in the field behind her house.) I knew she was doing her best to care for & protect my son & her other charges just as I was doing my best to care for my school "children". I believe, if memory serves me correctly, they were all in the bathroom in a bath tub with pillows over their heads. My son was safe in her care. Your family is in my thoughts and prayers as we return from Dallas tonight.
