Sidney passed away on Tuesday, March 29, 2016. He was 75 years of age. Sidney was born in Mason City, Iowa on July 5, 1940 to Ernest Harrison and Dorothy Winifred (Skewes) Melton. He attended high school in Hot Springs, Arkansas, graduating in 1959. Sidney faithfully served his country as a Green Beret in the United States Special Forces. Upon his honorable discharge, he went on to earn a Master's degree in Mechanical Engineering at the University of Tulsa. Sidney had a successful career as a Mechanical Engineer in the Oil and Gas Industry.

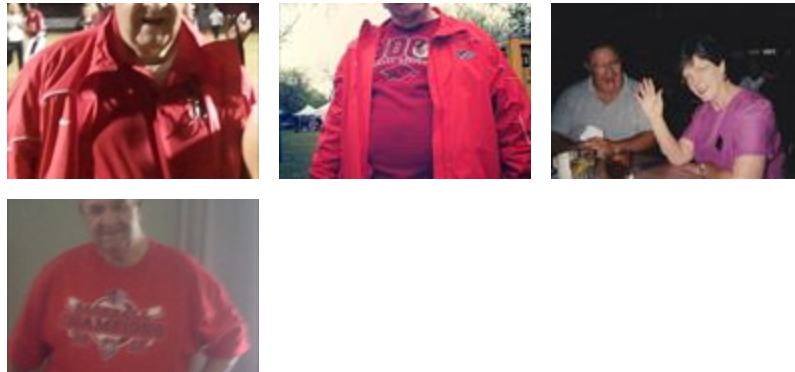
