Stephen Wayne Hanes was born in Claremore, Oklahoma, to parents David Lloyd and Erma Lee (Stamps) Hanes on Tuesday, October 23, 1956. He passed on to be with the Lord on Wednesday, February 4, 2026, in his home in Broken Arrow, surrounded by his loving family.

Stephen was one of two children growing up in Oklahoma. He graduated from Claremore High School in 1974. In his youth, he enjoyed hunting and fishing. He worked alongside his father as a steel-shop worker for twenty years before joining the United States Postal Service, which he loved. He married his late wife, Susan (Lawrence) Hanes, in September 1989, and they remained together until Susan's passing in January 2023. In his life, he had four children and a handful of beautiful grandchildren.

In June 2024, he married a wonderful woman, Becky (Johnson) Hanes, and shared much love and life until his recent passing.

Stephen ran his own church, Hope Family Church, and was in ministry with his late wife, Susan, and they had a YouTube Ministry called Hanes Ministries, Inc. 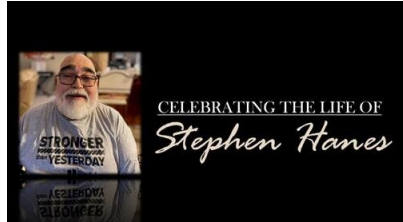

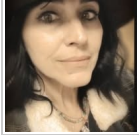
