Private funeral service for Theresa Hayhurst-Newcomb have been scheduled for Saturday, April 4, 2020 at the Hayhurst Funeral Home Chapel Interment will be on Monday, April 6, 2020 at Park Grove Cemetery, Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

Theresa A. Hayhurst-Newcomb was born on Sunday, February 28, 1932 in Sparks, Oklahoma, the daughter of Cecil and Pearl (Stewart) Johnson. She passed this life at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa on Thursday, April 2, 2020. She was 88 years of age.

The former Theresa Aline Johnson was a 1950 graduate of Shawnee, Oklahoma High School. Theresa worked as an Executive Secretary for the Superintendent of Shawnee Public Schools and as a clerk of Shawnee Public School Board of Education for several years. She was also the office manager at Graves Floral Company. In addition to her full time job, she also served as pianist for the Rotary, Kiwanis and Lions' Clubs in Shawnee, Oklahoma, and taught dozens of youngsters to play the piano.

Theresa was married to Jack R. Hayhurst on November 27, 1981. Together they, along with Jack W. and Pam Hayhurst, purchased the Marlin Funeral

Home in Broken Arrow on April 1, 1984. In subsequent years, she served as an Executive Assistant to the Vice-chancellor at OSU Tulsa. Jack Preceded her in death on January 15, 1992. Theresa was an accomplished pianist, organist and vocalist and used her talents in several different churches and civic organizations. Theresa was married to Dr. James Newcomb in 2008. He preceded her in death on May 22, 2016. Theresa loved her family, especially her grandchildren.
