



## Thomas L. Crow

Thomas (Tom) Lafayette Crow, 86, Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, passed from this life into the loving arms of Jesus Sunday, October 18, 2015.

Tom was born in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, on July 22, 1929, to James Marion Crow and Dellar (Ledbetter) Crow. After moving to Lake Station on the Sand Springs Line at a young age, Tom attended Sand Springs schools.
