Thomas “Tom” Loy Ferguson was born on Monday, September 25, 1944 in Monroe, Louisiana to Orland Hugh and Mileta Faye (Zeigler) Ferguson. He passed from this life on Monday, February 1, 2021 in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 76.

Tom graduated from Newellton, Louisiana High School in 1963, and then served in the U.S. Air Force. After his military service, Tom moved to Ponca City, OK where he married and had two daughters. Tom worked construction on Kaw Dam, H&N Sporting Goods, Huffy and Firestone before retiring from the City of Ponca City Parks and Recreation Department in 1996.

Through the years Tom was a Ponca City High School football referee, youth football coach, and member of the Ponca City AMBUCS.
