Services honoring the life of Truman Wiley will be 1:30 p.m., Thursday, February 15, 2018 at Arrow Heights Baptist Church. Burial will follow at Park Grove Cemetery.

Our precious Truman went to heaven to receive his crown on Thursday, February 8, 2018. He died peacefully in Gunnison, Colorado surrounded by family.

Truman was born on June 13, 1922 in Porum, Oklahoma to Samuel Alexander and Susie Elizabeth (Boatwright) Wiley. Truman grew up in Porum and graduated from high school in 1939. He joined the U.S. Air Corps in 1942 and served in World War II aboard a B-17 in Europe. On one perilous mission, Truman's plane was shot down behind enemy lines. He was secretly transported across enemy lines in a hay wagon by a farmer.

Truman married Anna Elizabeth Cravens on January 20, 1944 in Jenks, Oklahoma and when he left the Air Corps in 1945, they started a family. Truman graduated from Tulsa University in 1951 with a BS in Business Administration. This was no easy feat as he had a full time job, three small children and no car. He worked for various companies in the oil industry in Texas and Oklahoma, but spent the last 28 years of his professional life as comptroller of Albert Equipment in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Truman was a member of Arrow Heights Baptist Church where he was a deacon and served in just about every job there was. He and his wife, Anna, moved to Gunnison, Colorado in 2008 to be closer to their daughter. We will miss Truman; he was our family patriarch, our mentor and the best Christian we knew.

Truman is survived by his wife of 74 years, Anna Wiley, daughter, Wanda Anderson and husband Jim of Gunnison, CO, son Jerry Wiley and wife Jane of Tulsa, OK, son Jim Wiley and wife Cheryl of Bella Vista, AR, seven grandchildren, 17 great-grandchildren, and two great-great grandchildren.
