Scott was born on February 1, 1969 in Warren, Michigan to Dr. William Emmett Moore and Priscilla (Mullins) Moore. Scott unexpectedly passed away last week in Tulsa, at the age of 50.

Scott attended Eliot Elementary, Cascia Hall, Washington High School and graduated from Edison High School in Tulsa in 1987. He continued his education and earned a mathematics degree from the University of Oklahoma. Scott had a successful career as an Oracle Data Base Administrator and had most recently worked at Tinker Air Force Base. He had a quick wit, a great sense of humor, was very thoughtful, diligent, goal-oriented and driven, and held himself and others to a high standard.

He was compassionate, loyal, helpful, generous, and profoundly smart. He loved good food and drink, loved attending concerts, would always be ready to play piano at a wedding or help a kid with their math homework. He always struggled to find his keys and wallet and would usually leave his sunglasses at your house. He will be greatly missed and the silence will be deafening.
