William "Bill" was born on Thursday, August 30, 1917 in Glen Cove Long Island, NY the son of Jeroma and Theresa (Scala) Zuccala. Bill passed peacefully into his Savior's arms on Friday, March 3, 2017 at the age of 99.

Bill graduated from Glen Cove High School. Prior to his service in the military, he worked as a plumber, he played back up saxophone with the Jimmy Dorsey Band, and he was a caddy for Sam Snead Sr. He proudly served in World War II, under direct of General Patton, as Sergeant for the 6th Armored Division in the United States Army. He was the Lead Tank Commander in the Battle of Normandy, received 3 bronze stars. After the War he worked for El Paso Natural Gas Company in the Measurement Division and retired as Regional Foreman.

Bill married Grace Eleanor Macedon on October 1, 1945 in Tucson, Arizona. They were married 65 years and were blessed with two children, six grandchildren, and 13 great grandchildren. Bill was devoted to his wife, loved his family and was always willing to serve others. He was a carpenter at heart, loved working in his shop, and loved to cook his famous spaghetti and meatballs for family gatherings. He leaves a legacy of gratitude and love of

the Lord, of honesty, integrity, strength, perseverance, courage and honor. He and his wife were members of St. Anne Catholic Church.
